

# ISID Internship Programme

The ISID Internships expose students to policy-oriented research and analysis being conducted at the institute on strategic interventions to foster structural transformation and industrialisation in developing countries like India. These interventions cover, among others, global production networks, inward and outward foreign direct investment (FDI) flows, industrial finance, international trade and competitiveness, innovation and technology transfer, infrastructure, micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs), industrial clusters, industrial corridors and special economic zones (SEZs), corporate governance to promote industrialization and job creation.

Students completing the first year of their Masters courses in Economics, Business Economics, Business Administration, Economic Geography, and related disciplines from reputed Indian as well as international universities, interested in the broad area of industrial development may apply to join the Internship programme of the institute. Selected students will work under the supervision of ISID faculty. The duration of internship varies generally between 2-3 months and candidates can be accepted any time of the year.
